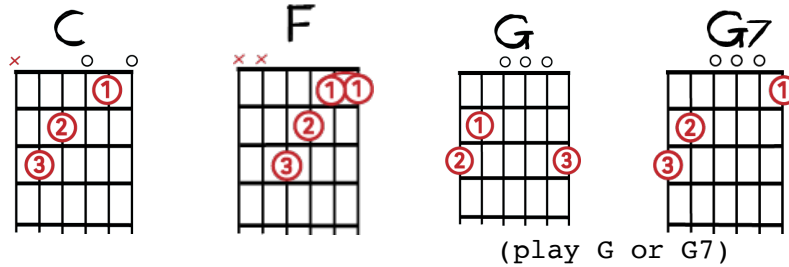


## JINGLE BELLS – Key of C

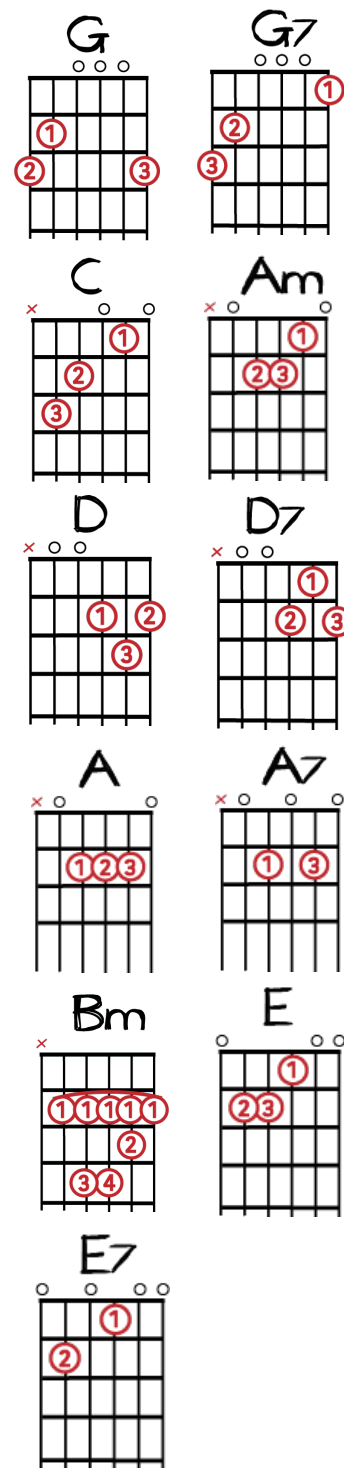

Let it snow, let it snow, let it snow.

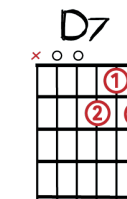
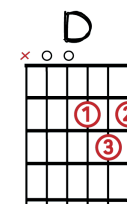
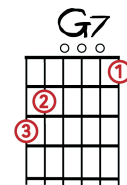
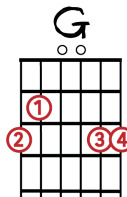
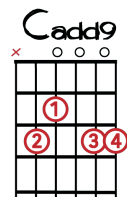
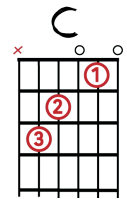

**C** Joy to the world, the **G** Lord is **C** come!

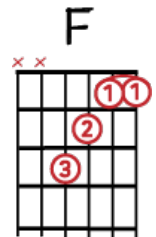
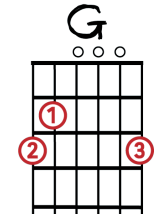
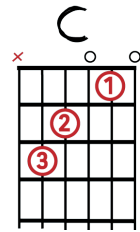
**F** Let earth receive her **G** King;
