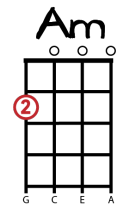


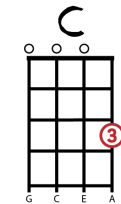
House of the Rising Sun – The Animals (6/8 time)

There is a house in New Orleans



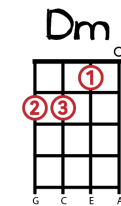
Am C E7

And it's been the ruin of many a poor boy



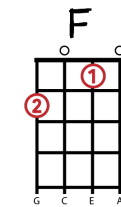
Am E7 Am

My mother was a tailor



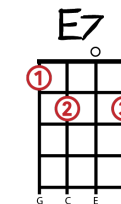
Am C E7
