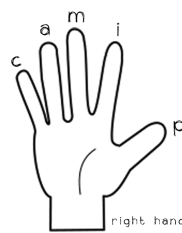

FINGER PICKING PATTERNS



- p = pulgar (thumb)
- i = índice (index)
- m = medio (middle)
- a = anular (ring)
- c = chiquito (pinky)
